THE UMBRELLA	A large golf umbrella is placed on the floor in the front of the Church. Everyone is invited to gather round the umbrella some people are invited to sit others to stand in a large circle. Various items are placed inside and outside the Umbrella. Glasses, whiskey bottle, milk carton, a clock, a whole plethora of goods. Perhaps the tools of a rock climber or a bank robber – which is it?  The people on the outside of the umbrella are invited to describe what they can see what is behind the umbrella. A torch is switched on creating shadows and clues for the people looking at the objects obscured by the umbrella. They then begin to describe what they think they are seeing. The thing is you've got to find out what kind of person would use these tools.
PRESENTER:	There's a story in the Bible about a man called Job. Everything went wrong in his life. He lost his home, his wife and his family. His friends interpreted the meaning behind all of his bad fortune as God's punishment for his sins. Job refused to believe it. He wouldn't allow himself to become cheesed off with God.
